# Where are we ....

- AMU & CLG still working positively on the construction and deployment of a Public Sector Licence
- Whilst these discussions continue AMU cannot share much of the detail as the License has still to be concluded
- CLG communicating PSL intentions and benefits with PAF users in the Public Sector and receiving positive support however...
- The complex task of getting the central funding co-ordinated and agreed is taking longer than may have been expected
- Currently looking at alternative ways in which we can support the introduction of the PSMA
- AMU still committed to getting the draft Public Sector Licence detail shared with PAB and the wider marketplace just as soon as is possible
- In the absence of a clear Agreement being in place normal licensing processes will continue to apply and returns will be captured in the normal way.



# Key considerations.....

- Need to ensure equity with terms for the Private Sector
- Membership – must be clear and visible
- PSL fees to be centrally managed and paid
- Need appropriate breakpoints in place in case of significant changes
- The transition to a Public Sector License needs to be properly managed
